Encouraging Child Sexual Abuse 1 x 10 counts

**Details:**

In March of 2008 members of the Southern Oregon High-Tech Crimes Task Force served a search warrant at Romantasy, an adult related business located at 3340 North Pacific Highway in Medford, Oregon. Several items of digital evidence was seized and later analyzed by forensic examiners within the Task Force.

At the completion of the forensic analysis the owner of that business, Robert Homer Wedel was cited and released at the Central Point Police Department without incident. Wedel was arrested on ten counts of Encouraging Child Sexual Abuse.

The Southern Oregon High-Tech Crimes Task Force has made the investigation of online sexual predators, and those who choose to exchange images of child pornography a top priority, and will continue to aggressively investigate, identify, and hold accountable those persons involved in Internet Crimes against Children.

The HTCTF is a multi-jurisdictional task force comprised of members of the Central Point and Medford Police Departments and performs High-Tech investigations and digital evidence forensics for over 30 federal, state and local law enforcement agencies.
